Public Health Advisory:

Healthcare Preparedness and Surveillance for FIFA Club World Cup Events (June 15th - July 13th) in New Jersey

Key Points:

- Be Vigilant for Travel-Related and Unusual Illnesses: While no specific health threat exists for this event, with the expected influx of domestic and international visitors, healthcare providers should maintain heightened awareness for travel-related illnesses, potential outbreaks, and any unusual clinical presentations that could indicate exposure to immediately reportable biological agents.
- 2. Review Disease Reporting Procedures: Promptly report diseases to public health authorities and highlight any potential links to attendance at a Club World Cup event.
- 3. Ensure Preparedness: Review and update your facility's emergency response and preparedness plans, coordinate with state and local partners and maintain situational awareness.

Immersive Virtual Reality for Improving Flood Evacuation Behaviour and Self-Efficacy

(Jàmbá - Journal of Disaster Risk Studies)

This research aimed to develop and test the effectiveness of the IVR Flood Evacuation Programme to improve knowledge and self-efficacy regarding flood disasters. The IVR developed consisted of three scenarios including actions that need to be taken before, during and after a flood. The results showed that IVR was effective in significantly improving knowledge on the best evacuation practices

and self-efficacy. However, regular flood disaster evacuation simulations are necessary to maintain the knowledge. This study recommends that training on flood disaster evacuation practices using IVR should be integrated into future disaster education programmes. This is important because transforming knowledge into action is the core of disaster education. Therefore, the IVR Flood Evacuation Programme has the potential to be applied as an engaging pedagogical tool for flood disaster evacuation training.
