Microsoft Releases Guidance on Exploitation of SharePoint Vulnerabilities

(CISA)

CISA is aware of active exploitation of a spoofing and RCE

vulnerability chain involving <u>CVE-2025-49706</u> and <u>CVE-2025-49704</u>, enabling unauthorized access to on-premise SharePoint servers. While the scope and impact continue to be assessed, the chain, publicly reported as "ToolShell," provides unauthenticated access to systems and authenticated access through network spoofing, respectively, and enables malicious actors to fully access SharePoint content, including file systems and internal configurations, and execute code over the network. Beyond the typical webshells, such as .aspx and .exe, .dll payloads have been observed during exploitation. Most recently, threat actors have also been observed encrypting files and distributing Warlock ransomware on compromised systems.
